He married ANN WILLIAMS Apr 04, 1713 in Gwynedd Monthly Meeting, Gwynedd Meeting House, Pennsylvania, daughter of JOHN WILLIAMS. She was born Nov 08, 1693 in Merion Township, Philadelphia Co., PA, and died Sep 10, 1773 in Richland, Bucks, PA.

Notes for HUGH FOULKE:

A memorial in Richland m.m., says: "He was a member of our meeting for about thirty years, the latter part of his life. He had a good gift in the ministry, which we believe he endeavored faithfully to discharge...."

Settled after marrying Ann Williams in Richland, Bucks Co.. He was a minister of the "Society of Friends" for 40 years.

After his removal to Pennsylvania, he was settled within the limits of Gwynedd meeting. He was early in life made subject to the cross of Christ; being found faithful in the duties assigned him by his divine Master, he grew in knowledge and experience. About the year 1720, he came forth in the ministry, in which service his labors were truly to the Comfort and edification of the church. Having had considerable share of experience in the progressive warefare of Christian life, he was qualified and frequently concerned to communicate suitable advice, counsel and exhortation, adapted to the various states of the people. He was zealously concerned to maintain and preserve peace and good order in the church, and to rule his own house as well. It was one of his principal cares, to bring up his children in the fear of the Lord, and early to inculcate in their minds the principles of virtue and truth. For this end, he used frequently to call them together when young, at suitable times, to wait upon the Lord; and (as ability was received) labored to imprint on their tender minds a just sense of the awful and solemn duties of religion.

He was much employed, under appointment of the Monthly Meeting, and under special religious concern, in visiting the families of Friends, to feel with them in their separate conditions, and as the Master furnished the necessary qualifications, labour for their good. In the year 1727, he was 5 times set at liberty for this kind of service, or appointed thereto, and in some other years, twice and thrice. Although he did not travel much abroad, he was an industrious laborer in the gospel, much beloved for the works sake.

When Friends began to settle in the neighborhood of Richland, he removed thither, where he continued to reside until his death, a period of about thirty years.

He departed this life the Fifth month 21st, 1760 in the 75th year of his age, and the 40th of his ministry.

Hugh Foulke, second son of Edward and Eleanor, was born at Coed-y-foel, Merionethshire, Wales 7mo. 6, 1685, and came to Pennsylvania with his parents in 1698, as shown by the narrative of his father. The family settled at the site of Penllyn, Montgomery Co., where Hugh resided until after his marriage in 1713. The date of his removal to the Great Swamp is not definitely known. He probably located immediately on his arrival on the tract of 313 acres on the west side of the "Road to Durham" now know locally as the "California Road" marked with his name on the map of the Manor of Richland. The railroad crosses this road on the part of this tract.

On the minutes of the Board of Property, 6mo. 28, 1734 (Penn Arch., 3rd Series Vol. i. p. 44) is the following:

"Hugh Foulke, in the first month 1732, requested grant of 200 acres of land in or about the tract called the Great Swamp and soon after settled and has built and improved the same, now requests to know the Proprietaries pleasure on what terms he may hold it.

The Proprietaries are pleased to grant the land at 35 per Ct. and 2 d per acre Quit rent."

The warrant of survey for this tract is dated 'March 22, 1733-4'. He probably fixed upon the bounds desired before the survey was made and the contents were ascertained to be 313 acres.

This acreage, however, included a tract of 40 acres on the east side of the road at the upper corner of the tract and immediately adjoining the upper part of the Joseph Gilbert tract later acquired by Theophilus Foulke, son of Hugh. The patent for this tract was not granted until January 21, 1740 (Patent Book A, Vol. 9, p. 441, Harrisburgh, Pa.)

On 11 mo. 16. 1756, Hugh Foulke and Ann, his wife, conveyed to their son, Theophilus Foulke, 206 acres of this tract, including the 40 acres on the east side of the road and the western half of the main tract. They probably conveyed to their eldest son, Samuel, at about the same date, the eastern half of the main tract lying along the west side of the road, which Samuel and Ann, his wife, conveyed to their son Israel in 1787. This latter deed shows the division line thru the main tract as it is shown on the "Draught of Sundry Tracts in Richland Twp", made by Samuel Foulke in 1767, where the said tracts are marked, respectively, 'Theos Foulke' and 'Samuel Foulke'.

It is entirely possible that Hugh Foulke had settled on this tract prior to his request for the grant thereof in 1732, as it was not unusual for settlers to 'locate' before applying for a survey. In the case of James Green the application was made after he had lived thereon 7 years.

We know that Hugh Foulke was located in the swamp in 1730, as on the 8th month 27th of that year he was named as an overseer of Richland Preparative Meeting, and it is quite probable that he was a resident there at the time of the organization of the Preparative Meeting in 1725, and possibly ten years earlier.

He was an accepted minister of the Society of Friends and served Richland Meeting in that capacity for upward of 30 years. He was one of the pioneers of the settlement in the Great Swamp, and he and his sons and grandsons were among the most prominent people of that section for a century or more. He died in Richland 5 mo. 21, 1760."

FIRST SETTLEMENT BY FRIENDS IN RICHLAND

By Samuel Foulke

At a Monthly Meeting held at Richland the 4th Mo. 15th 1775.

The Friends appointed by last Meeting to draw up an account of the first settlement of our Meeting to be transmitted to the next Quarterly Meeting, have performed the service as follows:

The first settlement of Friends in this place was about the year 1710 by an ancient Friend Peter Lester from Leistershire in England, who with his wife and children & other families became members of Gwynedd Monthly Meeting, and a Meeting for worship was, with the concurrence of that Monthly Meeting, held at the said Peter Lester's house for several years. Friends living in an amicable intercourse with the Indian Natives who at that time were numerous in these parts and often helpful to these new settlers in furnishing them with necessary provisions which is gratefully remembered by some yet living among us. About the year 1723 a small Meeting house was built (The Meeting House, built in 1723, was located at what is now known as Bethlehem Pike and Station Road. This may have been the location of the Bolton Tract referred to in "Four Sons of Hugh Foulke"- a portion of this chapter) and a preparative Meeting then held by the assent of the said Monthly Meeting, and Friends continuing to increase in numbers, by the youth growing up, and the accession of several families of Friends, from other places, it became necessary in the year 1730 to build a new Meeting House, which was done on a commodious lot of ground near the center of the settlement, and our said Meeting through the blessing of Divine Providence, both spiritually and temporally bestowed still continued increasing in strength and members until the year 1742 when Friends thought it expedient to make application to the Quarterly (?) Meeting held at Philadelphia in 1st of 9th Mo. 1742 to have a Monthly Meeting erected amongst themselves, which was granted them to be held the 3rd fifth day of the week in each month, and called Richland Monthly Meeting, which from that time has continued, and Friends here have since made considerable additions to their Meeting House to accommodate the Meeting.

The above account being approved by the Meeting was signed by order and in behalf thereof by

6-28-1735- "Edward Robert and Hugh Foulk are appointed Overseers of ye Swamp Meeting."

At the space of seventy years after their marriage, their offspring born amounted to 343 and since that time, as near as can be estimated, the number is increased to 500 at the present date (1810), of which number 115 were born of the name Foulke. The Hugh Foulke House

Originally published in the Foulke Family Herald, November 1993

It appears suddenly out of nowhere, and unless you are paying close attention, you might even miss it. The home of Hugh Foulke, second son of Edward and Eleanor, sits peacefully aLong the California Road just outside of Quakertown, PA.

Walking around the property, one gets a real sense of history. It is not very hard to picture early American colonists going about their daily routines or soldiers crossing the fields.

The original dwelling which housed Hugh, his wife Ann, and their eleven children consisted of only the single-room log cabin. The structure is about 30 feet by 20 feet, typical of early colonial times when settlers' main objective was to get the farmland established and producing food. Close examination of the construction reveals hand-hewn logs. The mortar was made of mud and straw. The roof overhang is supported by the braces used for the loft floor. The loft was used as sleeping quarters.

Inside, the cabin still boasts the original walk-in fireplace, random-width flooring (probably added later) and a very narrow staircase leading to the loft.

The only original outbuilding still standing is the bake-oven, constructed of stone. There was a springhouse and barn, but both were torn down, more for safety than anything since they had fallen into disrepair. The stone foundations are still partially intact, so it is easy to find where they were located.

The term "original" has been used a lot, but is very hard to convert to actual dates. Usually, it is easy to document when the land was acquired, but buildings are not so easy. Just because the land was purchased in 1740 does not mean you can date a home based on that information. People then, as now, built and tore down structures as they saw fit. Hugh Foulke's home is no exception to the rule and the more documentation I find, the more clouded the issue becomes. We know that Hugh and Ann (Williams) were married in 1713. We know he moved to Quakertown shortly thereafter. He requested a grant of 200 acres in the first month of 1732, but was already living on the land for which the warrant was requested. The actual Warrant of Survey is dated March 22, 1733-4, and the land patent for 313 acres was granted on January 10, 1740.

Officially he owned the land as of 1740, but all other records indicate he was living there prior to 1732. This was customary in the formative years of the colonies. Most landowners established their homes and followed through with legalities later on. It is safe to assume that the cabin is circa 1730, based on construction and records, but it could be older. Unless a diary of the missing 19 years (1713-1732) appears, we will likely never know for sure.

The stone portion was added later (date unknown as of this writing) and within the last decade another log cabin was added at the opposite end of the stone structure. This log addition was purchased in upstate Pennsylvania, disassembled, moved and then reassembled at its present location.

Of the 313 acres purchased in 1740 (or whenever), only 11 remain, but the property is stunning. The house is barely visible from the road, hidden by evergreens and an assortment of deciduous trees. A long driveway takes you past a small wooded lot containing two oak trees estimated to be at about 300 years old and quite possibly the largest trees in existence in Penn's woods. There is a small pasture which houses sheep and a large pond graced with weeping willows.

The present owners graciously host a tour of the house and property and they admit that even though they purchased it as a temporary residence, they have fallen in love with the charm and are intrigued with the history surrounding them. One piece of folklore they've heard is that the colonists who were transporting the Liberty Bell from Philadelphia to Allentown during the

Revolutionary War, stopped at this property to rest and water their horses. The bell was being moved to protect it from the British who planned on melting it down for cannon balls.

Another story she shared was that Mrs. Foulke (presumably another generation, but possibly Hugh's wife) was baking when some soldiers appeared on the property. They meant no harm and were only hungry. The frightened Mrs. Foulke gladly parted with her day's worth of fresh baked goods.

None of these stories can be documented historically, but these are fun and add some personal attachments to the history and founding of our country.

In addition to the history and the beauty of the homestead, the occupant informed us that she has reason to believe Hugh haunts the old log cabin. Resting on a deep window sill is a picture of her father. For reasons they cannot explain (and they have checked everything), this picture will suddenly topple over. Keep in mind that Hugh was a Quaker, and thus a conscientious objector. The owner's picture of her father is one of him in his soldier's uniform. If it is not Hugh, maybe it's the woman who spent all day baking only to turn it over to the soldiers!

Notes for ANN WILLIAMS:

Ann, a daughter of John Williams and Mary Evans, was born in Pembrokeshire, in Wales, Eleventh month 6th, 1693. Her parents, who were under conviction of the principles of Friends, removed to Pennsylvania with their family in 1700, and settling within the verge of Gwynedd Meeting, were soon after received into membership amongst Friends. They gave each of their children a sober carefully guarded education, and Ann being religiously inclined, from early youth, profited thereby. In the year 1713, she was married to Hugh Foulke, a religious man, who in a few years became an acceptable minister of the Gospel, and with whom she lived in great fellowship for many years. They labored to fulfill all their religious, domestic and social duties, and were especially concerned to bring up their children in the nature and admonition of the Lord. Ann grew in grace, and became a useful member of the Church militant. In the year 1727, a gift in the ministry of the Gospel was conferred upon her, in which she endeavored to be faithful, and her friends say "it was lively and edifying". In the year 1730, Hugh Foulke removed his family to Richland, of the meeting at which place Ann remained a serviceable member during her life. She was often weightily engaged with other Friends, in the religious service of visiting families, and in works of charity and benevolence, she was eminently distinguished among here Friends and neighbors of every denomination, which rendered her greatly esteemed and beloved.

She departed this life on the tenth day of the ninth month, 1773, in the eightieth year of here age.

Notes for SAMUEL FOULKE:

Samuel Foulke, a grandson of Edward through his son Hugh, served in the Pennsylvania Colonial Assembly from 1761 through 1768. Portions of a journal kept by Samuel reveal that he thought it no "remarkable" occurrence to receive mail from Benjamin Franklin, and even less so to meet with him on New Year's Eve of 1763.

To brother Moses a plantation in Brunswick Township called the Tanyard tract whereon Peter MILLER now lives, containing 257 acres.

Notes for THEOPHILUS FOULKE, SR.:

Theophilus Foulke represented Richland Meeting at the Quaterly Meeting in 1754, 1758 and 1760. He was one of the committee to erect new stables, in 1757; and in 1762 was appointed to inspect and audit the accounts of the committee appointed to erect an addition to the meeting-house.

He was a large landholder.

He took an even more earnest interest than his brothers, in the struggle for independence, and by being outspoken on the subject, incurred the antagonism of those members of meeting who emphasized their repugnance to war and war measures. He was accordingly disowned, and never returned to membership.

Notes for THEOPHILUS FOULKE, JR.:

Theophilus Foulke served in the Pennsylvania House of Representatives from 1794 through 1797. A great-grandson of Edward and Eleanor Foulke through Hugh and then Theophilus, Theophilus Foulke, Jr., had served as a Justice of the Peace in Pennsylvania before being elected to Congress. Theophilus, Jr., was once invited to dine with George WASHINGTON while he was president.

OBITUARY: "Listowel Banner" January 13, 1898.

"On Saturday morning last George Hughes, who for nearly thirteen years has been a highly respected resident of this section of country, died at the residence of his son-in-law, Mr. John Ballard, where he has made his home since he has lived here. He was in the 86th year of his age and for the past few years has not enjoyed good health although he was able to be about until two weeks ago. The old gentleman was of Quaker stock and was a notable example of the kindly disposition, the quiet even temperament and intelligence characteristic of his people. He lived through some of the most stirring scenes of Canadian history and was himself and his family directly connected therewith. During his residence here he made many warm personal friends who learned to respect and regard him highly. He retained many very vivid recollections of the early days in this country and it was always a pleasure to listen to his intelligent accounts of his experiences. As his end approached. He was quite ready for the release and even desired to be at rest. A little over six years ago on the occasion of his 79th birthday he drew up a short outline of the principal events in his life. Though this was evidently not intended for publication it is an interesting record, part of which is quoted below. It was written before the death of his wife who died in Walkerton about four years ago, and his son Mr. R.B. Hughes of Walkerton has also died since the sketch was written. Among other

things he says:

I was born April the 18th A.D., at Hughesville, in Roaring Creek Valley, Pennsylvania. The names of my father and mother were Jeremiah and Sarah Hughes who were members of the Society of Friends, commonly called Quakers. Our school privileges at this early date were very limited indeed, our would-be teachers would canvass the neighbourhood to see how many scholars he could obtain for the winter quarter, then he could tell how much to charge per head. He would have to board around amongst his employers according to the number sent. These schools were generally kept open three months in the year, so that what we learnt this winter would be forgotten by the next. The above has reference to country schools, not quite as bad in towns. At the age of 17 I left my dear old home, first I went to Mauch Chunk a small town on the Lehigh River, this is a great coal town the mines are nine miles from the town and river. I went to this town to learn to work iron under a triphammer, but this business soon closed, then I went to Catawissa to learn blacksmithing; served my apprenticeship for three years, then went back to Mauch Chunk and worked at my trade during the summer of 1832; went home in the fall and went to school during the winter months and returned in the spring again to my former place. In the fall of 1833 I came to Canada to see a sister and several uncles, aunts and cousins. My sister came to Canada a few years before me and was married to one Samuel Davis who had a wheelwright at Brownsville, now Schomberg, Township King, County York. He persuaded me to put up a shop beside him and start my trade. I got to be quite an expert in ironing wagons and Scotch ploughs. Here I worked for a little more than 2 years then I married my present wife, daughter of the late Benjamin and Mary Hawk. We have always kept up our New Years anniversary wedding day since, holding pleasant family re-unions. We moved to the Township of Wellesley, then called Queen's bush, in 1847 where Mr. John Hawk built a mill and laid out a village called Hawksville. Here I bought 150 acres of land and cleared up a farm and here I put in many a hard days work, cleared in 3 years 60 acres and built two barns, besides working considerable at my trade. In the fall of 1875 I sold all my property and on the 23rd May 1876 we moved to Norwich. Here I bought a house and two or three lots and afterwards built a new house more to our liking. Here we lived for eight years, but my wife's health becoming so poor we concluded to break up house keeping, and moved here to Listowel on 14th of May, 1885. We are now boarding with our oldest daughter, Eliza Ballard, and husband and live very Comfortably. Five years ago we celebrated our golden wedding with all our children and their companions with us and had a pleasant time. We had four sons and two daughters that grew up to be men and women. Our son-in-law and wife bought this farm adjoining the corporation of Listowel a little more than one year before we came to live with them. I helped them build a house suitable for themselves and us to live in.

Now I want to show what changes have taken place since I first came to Canada in 1833. At this time there was not a mile of railroad in Canada or the States except the little one from the mines to the river at Mauch Chunk. Little York had just changed its name to Toronto. At this time the only village north of Toronto was Newmarket with a population perhaps of 150 or 200 at most. Our north western country at this early date was scarcely known, only as the Hudson Bay Country; and now Ontario has rail roads running in every direction, and many thousand miles in operation - my age at this writing April 18th 1891 is 79 years.

!OBITUARY: "Listowel Banner" May 5, 1895.

"Few events have occurred in Walkerton that have called forth such general expressions of sadness as the death of Mr. R.B. Hughes. For some years he

has not been very rugged but his indomitable will and great energy caused him to make light of his trouble and attend to his ordinary business. About four months ago he spent some time at Battle Creek Sanitorium, Mich., and considered that he was much improved by the treatment. He struggled bravely against growing weakness until Saturday his friends were telegraphed for and it was expected that a few hours would tell the tale. His wonderful vitality surprised every one and it was not until Thursday evening that the end came. He suffered from a complication of diseases.

The deceased was the son of Mr. Geo. Hughes, of Listowel, and was born in the Township of Wellesley, Waterloo County, on December 14th, 1848. He received his early education in the public schools of his native township and the Berlin high school. He chose the dentist's profession and after going through the regular course took the degree of L.D.S. with honors in the spring of 1873. Shortly afterwards he located in Walkerton where for 22 years he enjoyed an extensive and lucrative practice. In October, 1874, he married Jennie, daughter of Mr. James Blair, who with four children - two sons and two daughters - are left to mourn the loss of a kind and loving father and husband. Two brothers - Mr. J.B. Hughes, Fire Inspector, Waterloo, and Mr. Frank Hughes, dentist, Galt, two sisters - Mrs. Ballard, Listowel, and Mrs. Lount, Walkerton, and his aged father survive him.

The funeral on Sunday was conducted by the A.F. & A.M., and the A.O.U.W., and was very largely attended.

Mr. Hughes was a man whom to know was to respect, and the better he was known the more he was thought of. His straightforward method of business combined with his generous and self-sacrificing disposition made him a general favourite. Like charity he thought no evil and had always a good word for everyone. He was skilled in his profession and always enjoyed an extensive practice. He took great interest in outdoor sports but particularly in curling. At the last annual meeting of the club he was elected president, but his impaired health prevented him taking an active interest in the game. As a skip he had few equals and his prowess on the ice was known all over the province. For two years he sat as a member of the town council, being elected by acclamation, but his inclination did not run in that line and he declined further honours. Altogether he was a model citizen and his loss to the town will be severely felt."

"Death of Mrs. Ballard - The sad news reached town yesterday morning that Mrs. Ballard, relict of the late John Ballard, had died in Galt Hospital, where she had gone to undergo an operation. Notes for JEREMIAH BOONE HUGHES:

Waterloo and the county suffered the loss of one of its oldest and most prominent personages in the death of Mr. Jeremiah B. Hughes, which took place about six o'clock on Thursday evening at his home on George Street. Deceased had been in declining health for several months owing to his extreme age, but it was only two weeks ago that he was compelled to take to his bed. Since then his remarkable constitution became weaker until he passed away surrounded by the members of his family. His death removed one of the landmarks of Waterloo and he will be greatly missed by a wide circle of friends who enjoyed his acquaintance and unusual social qualities. The funeral will be held on Saturday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock from the late residence to Mount Hope Cemetery.

The late Jeremiah B. Hughes was born on September 28th, 1836, in the village of Brownsville (now Schomberg), King's Township, York County, and was therefore in his 85th year. He was the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. George Hughes, and a direct descendant of William Hughes, who accompanied William Penn, with a number of brother Quakers on Penn's second voyage to America. His father was born in Hughesville, Pennsylvania, in 1811. He was a blacksmith and moved with his family from Brownsville to Hawkesville, Wellesley Township, when the deceased was but 11 years of age. A farm was purchased to which many acres were added when the Government finally decided to grant "squatters' rights" on the old Clergy Reserve land, a portion of which lay in Wellesley Township.

There was no school in Hawkesville in the days when the Hughes family migrated from York County, but through the efforts of the elder Hughes, who donated an acre of land at the corner of his farm for the purpose, a school house, which has long since been destroyed, was built. It was in this school that the deceased received his education. After leaving school he started life as a blacksmith, learning the trade from his father. He continued at this until he was 27 years of age, when he assumed charge of his father's farm for a period of four years.

About fifty-six years ago the deceased moved to Waterloo and entered career as an insurance man. After acting as an agent for the Waterloo Mutual Fire Insurance Company for a number of years he was appointed an inspector, which office he held for a period of twelve years. It was while he was connected with this company that his suggestion that the mutual insurance idea be applied to life as well as fire risks was acted upon and resulted in the founding of the Mutual Life Assurance Co., of Canada, whose head offices are in Waterloo.

About thirty years ago he became connected with the Aetna Fire Insurance Co. of Hartford, Conn. as Inspector and during recent years has been the special agent of the Company in Canada. He was known in all parts of Canada as one of the pioneer insurance men of the country, and for years has been the oldest insurance adjuster in the Dominion.

During his residence in Waterloo for over half a century the late Mr. Hughes always took a keen interest in its welfare. He was a member of the town council for a number of years, and in 1898 was mayor of the municipality. He was a life-long member of the Board of Trade and was an ex-president. He also took a great interest in the Kitchener-Waterloo Hospital, and was a faithful and useful member of the board for a score of years, eight of which he served as president. He retired two years ago and was honored with the office of Honorary President.

In politics Mr. Hughes was a Liberal, and for many years was the president of the North Waterloo Reform Association. He was married in 1848 to Laura J. Winn, daughter of the late Joshua and Mary Winn, of Wellesley Township, who survives and is in her 88th year. One son, Dr. Fred G., and one daughter, Mrs. (Dr.) Clayton Wells, also survive. Another daughter, Miss Laura, died a few years ago. The sympathy of a wide circle of friends will be extended to the bereaved wife and children in the loss they have sustained."
