The ruins of Barony Dunluce, a 13th Century Norman fortress lie dramatically on a cliff top. In the 16th Century the Clan MacDonnell captured and enlarged it, probably too much, because in 1639, the kitchens fell into the sea! Probably this MacHenry was a servant at the Castle. After this happened, the McDonnell's moved to another castle at Glenarm. The structure is reached by a wooden walkway, which replaced the drawbridge, and has 5 towers, linked by a curtain wall. It has a cave passage through the rock beneath the Castle which served as a secret exit.

Maurice (Morris, Moris) MacHenry was born in 1696 by Coleraine, near the Bann River and Giant's Causeway, Antrim, Ireland. Dating from the 5th century, B.C., it's principle industries are fishing, linen mills, and whiskey distilling. Signs of human habitation of the area is said to date back to around 7000 B.C.

The Giant's Causeway is a bizarre natural phenomenon that is the result of a massive subterranean explosion some millions of years ago, consisting of huge masses of mostly hexagonal pillars of black volcanic basalt, clustered like honeycomb extending down into the sea, resulting from an unusually steady cooling of lava, which stimulated crsytallization. These 40,0 00 thousand rocks are packed so tightly together that they almost form a bridge leading from the shore out to the sea.

Legend states a far diferent origin for the phenomenon. That Finn McCool, the warrior giant,

fell in love with a female giant on Staffa Island, off the Scottish coast. the devoted lover built the Causeway to bring her across to Ulster, a story which explains the existence of similar beehive-esque rock formations on Staffa. The legend continues to tell of McCool's desire to fight the Scottish giant Benandonner. But when he realized how big his Scottish rival was, McCool decided to use wit instead of brute force. The giant, with the help of his wife, disguised himself as a baby. When Benandonner saw the size of the Irish "baby" he was terrified by the anticipated proportions of the father. He quickly fled back to Scotland, destroying the Causeway on his return trip in order to ensure that the huge father McCool and would never be able to cross the sea to challenge him.

In 1739, at the age of 14, he came to New York from Ireland on a ship chartered by James Clinton, father of DeWitt Clinton, first governor of the State of New York. It is evident that the youthful McHenry remained in the company of the Clinton family for some time for we learn that he accompanied James Clinton, at the age of 16, on an expedition into the Mohawk Valley NY, to trade with the Indians.

In 1750, he married his cousin, Susannah McNeil (McNeal), who was born at Giant's Causeway, Ireland in 1726 and emigrated to America at the same time John did. They settled along the Hudson River at a point now called Lime Kiln, Orange Co., NY and their 9 children were all born there.

The pioneer was an expert hunter and trapper and had considerable success in trading with the Indians. Having secured some education before leaving Ireland, he was able to teach each of his sons to read and write and sing Irish songs.

He took part in the affairs of the colony. According to the records of the new York Historical Society, John McHenry served as Major in the First New York Battalion during the French and Indian War of 1756-57.

In 1773 the family came to Pennsylvania by way of New Jersey. Settled along Chillisquaque Creek in Northumberland Co., PA which at the time was complete wilderness area. There, three comfortable log cabins were built and considerable land put under cultivation.

Immediately following the Wyoming massacre in 1778, the McHenrys were forced to flee to the protection of Fort Augusta at Sunbury. After the Indians suffered defeat and were driven out of Central Pennsylvania by the army of General Sullivan, John McHenry with his wife and younger children returned to their partially destroyed home on the West Branch. He enlisted, 1778, as a private in Capt. Thomas Robinson's company of volunteers.

John McHenry and four of his sons are named on the payroll of Revolutionary soldiers

preserved in the Pennsylvania Archives, 3d Series, Vol. 23, Pages 202,220,230,332, 346 and 349. The name of John McHenry is one of thirty eight signed to a petition of the inhabitants of Northumberland County, Pennsylvania dated December 18, 1781 petitioning the Honorable Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to "Consider their situation on the frontier exposed to Indian outbreaks, and not to withdraw the militia company of Captain Robinson that had been raised for defense of frontier".

John McHenry died at Chillisquaque and was buried in the Chillisquaque Presbyterian graveyard near Potts Grove.

Following the death of John McHenry, his widow Susannah made her home with her oldest son, Daniel at Stillwater, Columbia County, Pennsylvania.

Daniel McHenry, first offspring of John and Susanah McNeal McHenry
"Blazes a Trail in Fishingcreek Valley"

The young Daniel was a hunter and trapper, with little save his knowledge of woodcraft as a means of support. The parents of the maiden of his choice opposed his suit. They threatened to send their daughter away, to the "Nuns" at Bethlehem on the Lehigh. "They cannot send you farther than I can go after you" said Daniel. And so, he won his bride and took her to the newly made settlement on the West Branch while he went off to war.

In the Revolutionary War, Daniel McHenry served with Company B, Northumberland Regiment, first as Lieutenant, then as Captain. (Military Minutes of the Council of Appointment of the State of New York, 1783-1821) In Meginness' History of the West

Branch, published 1857, page 190, is mention of the company commanded by Lieutenant Daniel McHenry, at the battle of Red Bank.

Daniel McHenry was commissioned Captain September 11, 1777. He was wounded at the battle of Red Bank, being shot through the ear and given a slight scalp wound, the scar of which he would sometimes show to his descendants.

At the time of the Indian massacres of 1778, Daniel McHenry was at Chillisquaque having come on furlough to defend his family on the unprotected frontier. At the time of the Big Runaway, he did not flee

with the others but waited until reflections of burning cabins up the river warned of immediate danger. Taking his two horses, his wife, two children and a feather bed, he crossed the river that was swollen beyond its banks by a great freshet. The night was pitch dark and they could not see the opposite shore. "Daniel I cannot cross t his dreadful river" said the young wife.

"You must, else 'tis the river of death at the bloody hands of the Indians", her husband told her. Tied on her horse with rope about her waist in the hands of her husband, she shut her eyes and gripped her baby. She could hear her husband whispering to his horse as they swam the swift current "take us through, brave Bevan, take us through". She knew they had reached the shore when he said "God of mercies, I thank thee".

At the first house to which they came they were received and cared for generously. Their next child was named for their benefactor, Daniel Butterfield. There are many descendants of Daniel Butterfield McHenry in Central Pennsylvania.

After being driven out by the Indians, Daniel McHenry did not go back to the West Branch but sought a place in what was then the unbroken wilderness of upper Fishingcreek Valley. In 1784 he made his first trip of exploration up the valley, following the Indian trail up the creek from the frontier settlement which is now the town of Bloomsburg, to choose the place where he and the generations after him should live.

The site he selected was on a slight elevation overlooking the creek and the valley at Stillwater. The home of the late Daniel McHenry, grandson of Daniel the 1st, and of O.D. McHenry, great grandson, now occupies the same site.

Early in 1785, Daniel McHenry made his second trip up Fishingcreek. This time he took with him his axe, his gun and his dog and some grain for seed in his knapsack. All summer he labored, felling tRees and building a log house. By fall he was ready for his family to come to their new home. They had been left with her father at Chillis quaque. Daniel McHenry "took up" or purchased from the state something over a thousand acres of land. In the earliest patent, dated 1793, the consideration mentioned is twenty pounds for 800 acres, something less than ten cents per acre. This tract was called "Manchester Manor" and with succeeding purcha ses extended from what is now called Pealertown to the site of the old McHenry Distillery and the lower end of the borough of Benton.

Daniel McHenry was described by one of his grandchildren as a spare, florid complexioned man of medium height, erect carriage and small, well cared formed hands and feet. In his later years, he was thrifty anc economi cl and acquired considerable property. A strict Presbyterian and far from any church, he would call together his children and neighbors and lead them in exhortation. The grace he asked before meals was "Chief, bless us".

Dispite disase and hardship of pioneer life, he gave throught to the mental training of his children and, early in 1794, he hired a young man from Philadelphia, Henry Heiss by name, to stop at his home for three months to teach his children.

"Mr. John McHenry, an old and respected citizen who died in Benton township, March 17, 1868 at the age of 82 years, 6 months and 4 days, and who was born at stillwater, a few miles above Orangeville, in the year 1785, says that at the time of his birth, two or three shanties stood where Orangeville now stands. Mr. McHenry was the first white child born north of Orange on the famous Fishingcreek, and he spent his whole Long life upon its waters. He was a most successful and aocomplished hunter, and killed during his career more than two thousand deer. He was what was called a still hunter. No dogs ever tracked he game through the forest for him. A nice ear, quick eye and an unering rifle made success certain.. Although deer were his principle sport, yet all kinds of game, especiallywild turkeys, were among those whose chase was most exciting, and whose capture was most satisfactory, on account of the delicious flavor of the flesh, as welll as the skill required to secure them."

Death of Rohr McHenry. Well known Benton Distiller passes away. Rohy McHenry Distilling Company of Columbia county, is dead. His demise, which was due to the effects of a sunstroke, occurred yesterday at noon.

Mr. McHenry was born near Benton seventy-seven years ago and spent his entire life thereabouts. For many years he was in the mercantile business, and was also the leading ?? of the Rohy McHenry Distilling Co., a concern that was established in 1812 by his father. He was one of the heaviest owners of real estate in Columbia county and leaves a large estate. He was wellknow throughout the State. Eighteen years ago his wife died and surviving him is his only son, John G. McHenry.

Mrs. Rohr McHenry was a daughter of the Geisers, who for many years ran the hotel at the foot of North Mountain. She was a very beautiful woman and was noted for her many charities; the present Presbyterian Church was built mainly by her aid, and she alWays remembered the poor.

The old North Mountain Hotel was a great hostelry in the early days, drivers with their cattle from Towanda over the old turnpike making it their stopping place. In the hunting season it was alWays well filled with deer hunters and it was while Rohr McHenry, then a young man, was on one of these hunting trips that he met and fell in love with the beautiful daughter of the Geisers. His hunting trips became frequent and were the excuse for his ardent courtship and marriage, and she and her parents quit the mountain and came to town. A private cemetery at the foot of the mountain is occupied by the Geiser family.
